## Overview

In 2010, the Mayor's Summer Jobs Program helped **1,159<sup>1</sup> Oakland youth** 14-24 gain work experience through a summer job at hundreds of local **employers**. All told, the summer jobs program paid **\$1,264,886 in wages** to Oakland teens and young adults.
